The Guyana High Commission in Ottawa in conjunction with the Consulate General of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana in Toronto, Canada, wishes to inform the Guyanese Diaspora in Canada, that Guyana has been experiencing for the past several days, an unprecedented level of intense rainfall which has resulted in severe flooding in several parts of Guyana.

The flooding has disrupted economic activities in the affected areas and has also resulted in the loss of farms, livestock and homes. In an effort to mitigate the situation, the Civil Defense Commission (CDC), the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Agriculture and other agencies are on the ground conducting continuous flood assessments and providing much needed assistance to all those communities which have been adversely affected.
